

Throwback: Lillo Thomas-I'm In Love



[Lillo](#) Thomas grew-up in Brooklyn, New York and became a track star by the time he was 16. He set the world record for the 200 meter and it made him eligible for the Olympics but a car accident changed his career plans. Trading sports for music, his launch in the R&B singing world found him doing session work for James Ingram, Kashif, Melba Moore and others. He got a solo deal with Capitol and by 1985 he was touring with Eddie Murphy. Paul Laurence and Kashif's keen songwriting and production provided Lillo's discography with ["You're A Good Girl,"](#) ["Your Love's Got A Hold On Me,"](#) ["Sexy Girl,"](#) ["\(Can't Take Half\) All Of You,"](#) ["Settle Down,"](#) ["I'm In Love"](#) and ["Wanna Make Love \(All Night Long\)."](#) He recorded three albums for the label with the last one, *Lillo*, from 1987 being the most popular. Thomas would not release any music again until 2007's *How Can I Look Her (In The Eye)* for the digital label Fitingo Music.
