

Throwback: Yahzarah-Same Page

Yahzarah is a Washington, D.C. bred soprano who broke into the music industry in 2000 as a back-up singer and opening act for Erykah Badu. [“Feel Me”](#) was her first single to come out in 2001 on the Keo Music Records label. *Hear Me* was her debut album that emerged in 2002 and it contained the two singles, [“Love Is You”](#) and [“Natural.”](#) Two years later her sophomore effort *Blackstar* would come out on the Three Keys label. “Same Page” is from the *Blackstar* project but the singles included [“Wishing,”](#) [“Blackstar”](#) and [“One Day.”](#) The Foreign Exchange featured her on [“Sincere”](#) from their 2005 album *Connected*. In 2008 she created *The Prelude* which was an EP of eight songs that she promoted by touring with Chaka Khan, R.Kelly, The Roots and Musiq. *The Ballad of Purple St. James* was released in 2010 on Foreign Exchange Music.
