Bernard "Pretty" Purdie has played drums for a long line of soul and jazz legends including, but not limited to, Aretha Franklin, James Brown, Nina Simone, Miles Davis and Gil Scott-Heron over his 6-decade career. He started recording as a bandleader in the '60's with the album Soul Drums. His Purdie Shuffle drumming technique which he perfected with the use of triplets against a half-time backbeat is credited for being a major influence on funk. Filmmakers Marc Manseau & Helgi Piccinin launched an Indiegogo campaign this month to raise \$50,000 for the completion of the *Purdy Good Life* Documentary. They have a few more weeks to reach their goal and there are perks ranging from production crew membership to executive producer credits.
