Cherri V's Brown Eyed Soul EP arrives after an 18-month journey and a preview with the singles "Leave Me Be," "Things You Do," and "Swimming." The British singer-songwriter counts Hannah V as one of the album's producers and there is an appearance from U.K. R&B singer Terri Walker. Cherri V explained the title in a press release:Â
