

Listen: Will Colloan Reconfigures Stevie Wonder's Black Man



Producer Will Colloan aka Brennan Williams reconstructs Stevie Wonder's "Black Man" in honor of Wonder's message during the pandemic and worldwide fight for social justice. Colloan remixed the song with an Afrobeat aesthetic inspired by Fela Kuti's politically driven *Zombie* album. He says, "Overall, I want the remix to serve as a beacon of light, empowerment, and a celebration to all black men and mothers of black boys across the globe." "Black Man" is on Stevie Wonder's groundbreaking *Songs In The Key Of Life* double album from 1976. Colloan sees how Wonder's sentiments 44 years regarding the overlooked achievements of Black men are still having reverberations today.
