It's about the ultimate confusion when someone is giving you mixed signals to the point where you begin to wonder whether they're doing the same thing with somebody elseâ€\ When a situation is not progressing, efforts are not reciprocated, and it's all talk and no action, it feels like it's more headspace than it's worth.Â
