

Skyler Reed Details A Departure On New Single I'm Gone

Skyler Reed addresses the end of a chaotic relationship with her single "I'm Gone." The Atlanta singer's vocals ease into the turmoil of a darkened place with the bravura of her jazz background. Reed expresses agitation but her exit leans more towards a classy goodbye because there is no anger. Producer Jolliyah Melodygod helps Reed tell the story with music influenced by drum and bass and R&B. The perky beats signify Reed's moving away from a dangerous headspace. Melodygod captures the drama of the situation in the tense strings that sound the alarm for self-survival. Reed released her *Are We There Yet?* EP earlier this year.
