Karriem Riggins releases his *To The Jungle* album via The Madlib Invazion Music Library founded by Madlib and Egon during the pandemic. Riggins works out various rhythm patterns with a collection of songs that will entertain beat junkies and provide source material for producers. The drummer also released “Massamba Afundance” with Madlib from their forthcoming joint album *YHWH is LOVE*. Their newest collaboration will be the first release on Riggins’s Law Of Rhythm label he co-founded with Jae Barber. *YHWH is Love* comes out on March 1st.

Rae Khalil performs the sultry “Is It Worth It” in a club setting with her band. Her soulful vocals, the musicians, her backup singers, and the choreography will make some call her the next wave of neo-soul. She got her start as a contestant on Netflix’s music competition show Rhythm + Flow in 2019. “Is It Worth It” is Khalil’s debut single and the smoothness of it all brings up the question of when she will release her full-length album.

Frankie Beverly is going on a final tour with his band Maze this year. The “I Wanna Thank You Farewell Tour” kicks off in Atlanta on March 22nd. Chaka Khan and El DeBarge will join Beverly and his band which has its first show at the State Arena. The group has toured for five decades and released eight studio albums and two live albums. Their songs “Joy And Pain,” “Running Away,” “Golden Time Of Day,” “Happy Feelin’s” and “We Are One” are classic hits that have become synonymous with any kind of celebration with R&B fans around the world. Beyoncé famously recorded “Before I Let Go” for her 2019 *Homecoming* film. Their final trek together is being produced by The Black Promoters Collective which includes six of the nation’s premier independent concert and event promotion companies.

Beverly just received the Urban One Living Legend Honor from TVOne along with Dionne Warwick, Mary J. Blige, gospel

producer Donald Lawrence, and Chloe. When the tour ends he will make a stop in his hometown of Philadelphia for a street naming ceremony because that is where they started under the name Raw Soul.
