Goldie Is Releasing The 30th Anniversary Edition Of Timeless



Goldie's classic drum and bass album, *Timeless*, has been remastered for a 30th anniversary edition. *Timeless* was cinematic and magical and became a representative album for the genre in its appeal. Thirty years later and the album is still praised and discovered by old fans and the younger generation of electronic music fans. To commemorate this landmark anniversary, a series of very special limited edition physical versions of *Timeless* will be released: 2LP White Vinyl, 2LP Gold-on-Clear Vinyl, and Transparent Blue Cassette. They are available for pre-order now and will be released on November 7. In addition, a unique collaboration with [The Vinyl Factory](#) sees Goldie return to the source, joining friend and fellow drum and bass pioneer Grooverider at the record pressing plant to hand-press a run of 500 limited edition *Timeless* records. These exclusive editions feature hand-stamped sleeves and custom colorways selected by Goldie himself. Prince's Sign O' The Times Gets An IMAX Debut



Prince's *Sign O' The Times* concert film will be seen in IMAX for the first time next month. IMAX, Mercury Studios and FilmRise have partnered to bring the 1987 companion movie to Prince's album of the same name to IMAX screens for a limited time starting August 29, 2025. Prince directed *Sign O' The Times*, which featured Sheila E., Cat Glover, and his post-Revolution band. *Sign O' The Times* is Prince's ninth album and many critics have argued that it is his best. "If I Was Your

Girlfriend,” “Adore,” “U Got The Look,” and “I Could Never Take The Place Of Your Man” all came from *Sign O’ The Times*, which was originally a three-album project until Warner Brothers convinced Prince to make it a double. The film was just as thrilling as the album and the adaptation to the IMAX format will deliver the visuals and sound with greater depth and optical intensity.
