Disco D dead at age 26

DJ was an innovator in ghetto-tech music

David (Disco D) Shayman was the kind of young musician who would lend a shoulder to his friends when they were going through life's low moments. It was nothing for Shayman to repeatedly check in and offer encouraging words.

The Ann Arbor-bred DJ and music producer who made his name as an innovator and DJ in the ghetto-tech scene – and went on to work with big-name hip-hop stars such as 50 Cent and Chamillionaire – was found dead on Tuesday in Washington, D.C.
