Doomtree announces the Doomtree Zoo, an all-day event at CHS Field, the new ballpark of the St. Paul Saints, with performances from Doomtree, Aesop Rock with Rob Sonic, Trash Talk, Shabazz Palaces and Open Mike Eagle. October 3rd, 2015.

The Minneapolis rap collective will headline the show after coming off their international tour for their *All Hands* album. Tickets go on sale to the public on Saturday, August 1st at 11am CST. Members of Doomtree will be selling tickets hand-to-hand at the CHS Field box office from 11am-1pm, so swing through to say hello and get a glimpse of the ballpark. Online tickets will be available for purchase [here](#). Tickets are \$35 in advance and \$45 at the door. A very limited number of Baller Passes are also available. Pass-holders will be able to enter the stadium before doors to watch the Doomtree soundcheck; get a photo with the crew and participate in a Q&A; score an autographed poster, a Doomtree drawstring bag, a couple of drink tickets, and a Doomtree Zoo laminate. They'll also be able to watch the show from the Securian Club with a dedicated bar, restroom, and balcony. Passes are \$100. A total of 300 will be sold.

Doomtree will be hitting up each coast this Fall on the Off In The Deep Tour. Astronautalis will join them on the West Coast dates.

# Sims Announces 10-Year Anniversary Edition Of Lights Out Paris June 30th



In celebration of the 10-year anniversary of *Lights Out Paris*, Sims announces the release of the album's deluxe edition, out June 30th on Doontree Records. Available digitally, and on vinyl for the very first time, the deluxe edition of *Lights Out Paris* contains newly remastered audio, full written lyrics, and nine new bonus tracks, including remixes from original album producers Lazerbeak, Paper Tiger, MK Larada, and Joe Mabbott, as well as Sims' rare 2004 *False Hopes Four* EP. The iTunes instant grat track "15 Blocks (Lazerbeak Remix)" can be streamed here and purchased with the digital pre-order here. Doontree Records is also offering an exclusive deluxe vinyl pre-order through their webstore, which includes all of the content listed above, as well as a double LP, large fold-out poster, limited t-shirt/patch/button/sticker pack, and special access to a private Sims Livestream performance and hangout on July 15th.

*Lights Out Paris* was originally released in 2005, and marked the first full-length album from the Doontree rapper. Featuring staples like "Key Grip (Fax)" and "No Homeowners," the album includes guest verses from early associates Toki Wright and Crescent Moon, and fellow Doontree members P.O.S, Dessa, Cecil Otter, and Mike Mictlan. Fans have been able to watch Sims grow and evolve over the past decade, showcased in more recent releases like *Bad Time Zoo*, *Wildlife*, and *Field Notes*, and now this deluxe edition reissue of *Lights*

*Out Paris* gives us a definitive glimpse into where it all began.
