The trailer for the new album reveals how his 2017 eviction from a mansion in Atlanta because of the owner's financial irresponsibility sent him and his group back to Africa. He was inspired by the situation and saw it as a symbol of the Black experience because even though the bills

were paid they were still displaced and out of a home. African-Americans can do what is expected of any good American and not escape the pitfalls of racism.Â
