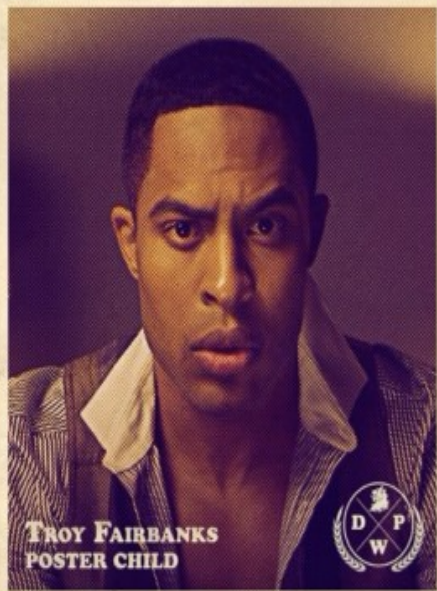
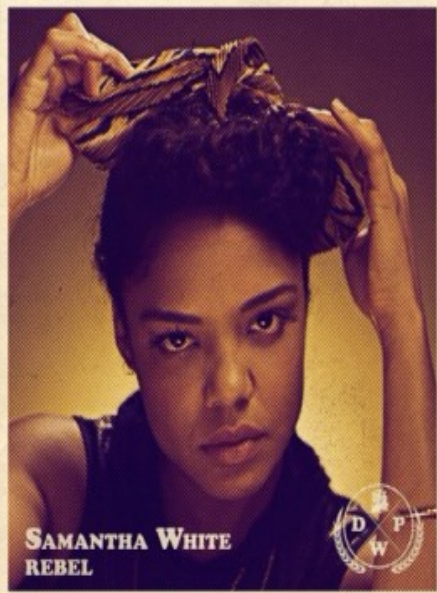


Dear White People Opens This Weekend
