We Are KING is headlining a show in Los Angeles October 12th at the Ford Theatres. Twin sisters Amber and Paris Strother released their debut album *We Are KING* in 2016 and were praised by the media and developed a weighty fan following. The album received a Grammy nomination and they were situated within the Top 10 area of Billboard's Independent and R&B Albums chart. It was all a part of a good omen that gave them the fortune to have Prince as a mentor and advisor after he heard their 2011 *The Story EP*. It will be their first time performing at Ford Theatres and there are plans to present their older music with different arrangements and to premier some of their new material.
