Porter is accustomed to working fast because he told the audience how he, Proof and J.Dilla would have 10-minute beat-making contests.

MFSB's "Love Is The Message," the soundtrack to an '80's film called *Blue Thunder* and Logg's "I Know You Will" were the perfect pieces to go with the guitar from Hawthorne, communal handclaps and synthesizers. The final production only needed vocals, lyrics and another one of their cool videos to finish the deal.
