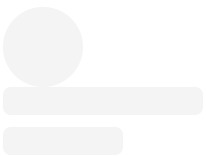

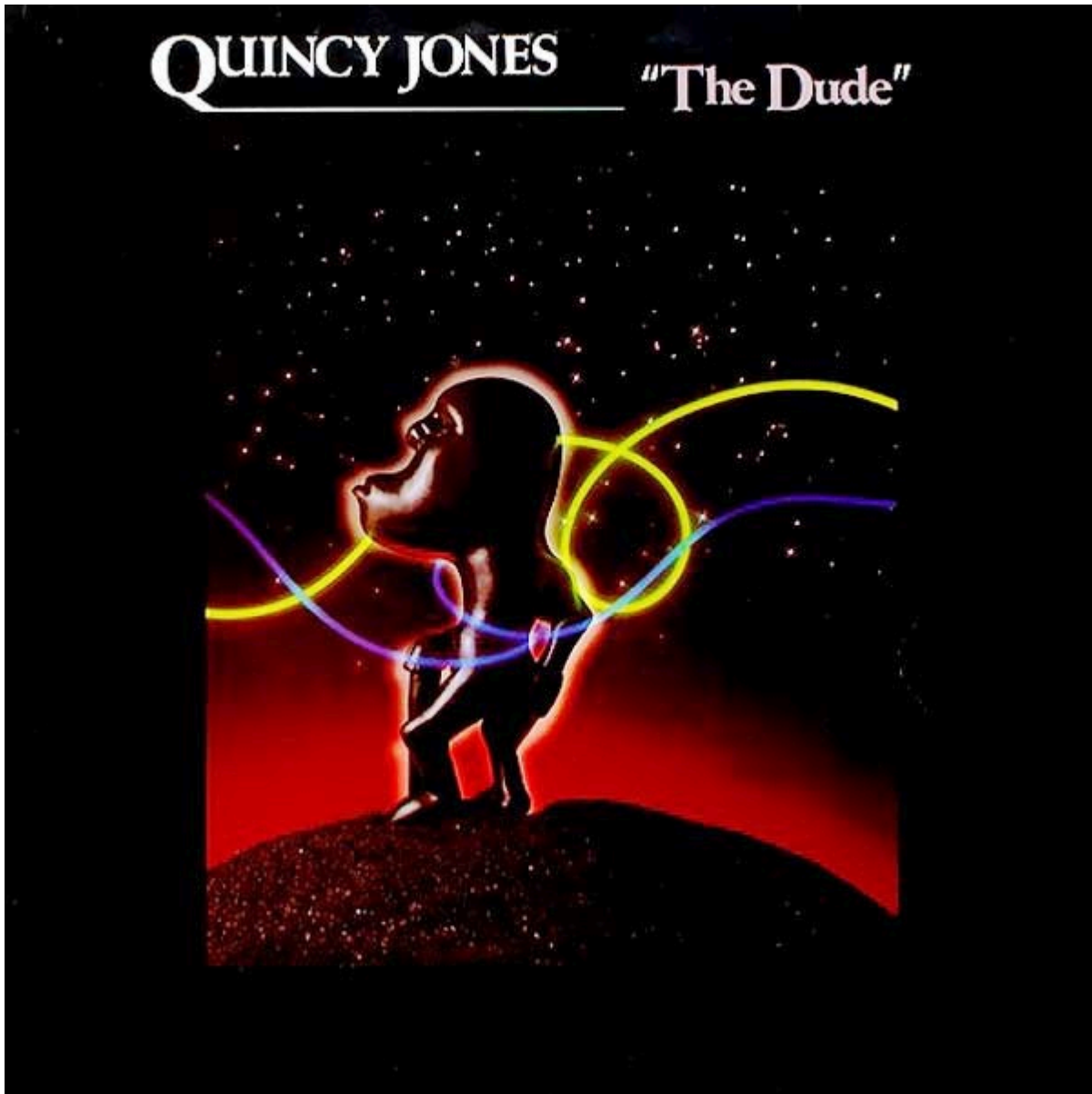
## Throwback: Quincy Jones - Betcha Wouldn't Hurt Me Feat. Patti Austin

Quincy Jones recorded "Betcha Wouldn't Hurt Me" with Patti Austin as the featured vocalist for his 1981 R&B album *The Dude*. Stevie Wonder, who had known Jones since he was 14-years old, wrote "Betcha Wouldn't Hurt Me." It was not the first time Jones had recorded a song written by Wonder: in 1973 he covered and titled an album after "You've Got It Bad Girl" and also included his version of "Superstition." Patti Austin previously worked with Jones who is also her godfather on the soundtrack to *The Wiz* and his *Sounds...And Stuff Like That!* album both in 1978. Two years before *The Dude* Jones produced Austin's "It's The Falling In Love" collaboration with Michael Jackson from his *Off The Wall* album. Austin's velvety tone sang lead on four songs from *The Dude* and "Betcha Wouldn't Hurt Me" was uptempo and most suited for clubs and dancefloors. Austin and Jones had a magical 1981 with *The Dude* receiving 12 Grammy nominations and taking home three awards. Austin's *Every Home Should Have One* also came out that year on Jones's Qwest label and he produced her no. 1 duet with James Ingram "Baby, Come To Me." [The Dude](#) received a color vinyl release in June of 2021.

Austin's most recent studio album is her 2016 *Mighty Musical Fairy Tales*. She was part of the tribute concert for Jones's 75th birthday released in 2009 as *The 75th Birthday Celebration*. Patti Austin is scheduled to perform at the [2021](#)

Chaka Khan, Ledisi, Sheila E., Lisa Fischer, Dee Dee Bridgewater, India.Arie, Lalah Hathaway, Patti Austin, Terri Lyne Carrington, Siedah Garrett and Brenda Russell have formed TWIST(Tuff Women In Strange Times) a supergroup of women artists to rally voter participation for the 2020 election. Activist, author and professor Angela Davis will appear in a series of videos encouraging voting under the TWIST2020 banner. Austin, who is the brainchild behind TWIST, says the campaign is to remind voters particularly women of the historic power they have to make a difference especially in light of September 18, 2020, passing of Supreme Court Justice Ruth Bader Ginsburg. She says, "We've all got incredible stories about a school teacher, our mother, or her mother, or just other powerful women that influence our lives. We've got this election coming up. We have the power of the world in our hands, given to us by the women who came before us."
