Sa-Roc delivers her Rhymesayer's Entertainment debut *The Sharecropper's Daughter* and it's an introspective trip through her politics and pride in her craft. Sol Messiah handled most of the production on the album that has moments with Ledisi, Black Thought, Saul Williams, Chronixx and Styles P. Guest producers Evidence and Al B. Smoov also added their touch to

the music. Sa-Roc mused about *TSD* in a statement:Â

*“I’m excited about the content of it. It’s especially timely because it talks about the cycle of injustice we experience in this country. The cycle of emotional baggage in genetic transfer of that emotion; how it frames our perspective and what we can do to reshape a legacy and future for ourselves outside of that trauma and pain we inherit from history, our ancestors, our elders.”*

Sa-Roc was still able to create a level of festivity despite the seriousness of the topics.
