â€¢ Equus Maximus After 3 years of begging and ingratiating, Jerry Vile has convinced NY artist, Gregory de la Haba to display his controversial sculptural installation, "Equus Maximus." De La Haba's unforgettable installation caused a stir at the 2008 Art Basel in Miami, will be the centerpiece of the 14th version of The Dirty Show. Curator Vile has called the taxidermy and sculpture based piece, the best piece of erotica I have ever seen.

â€œNew York multimedia artist Gregory de la Haba's not-to-be-missed masterpiece Equus Maximus is ambitious to say the least, involving life-size taxidermy show-horses in full Vegas dance-hall regalia, and sporting exaggerated sex organs, a casino table, a suite of lavishly staged, ornately costumed photographic portraits, a soundtrack, and mood lighting. The overall effect is at once baroque and erotic, emotionally charged, and animated by a certain primitive, tribal sorcery that lends a deep soulfulness to the tableau's splashy titillation
